CALOR 2006, the twelfth in this series, will be held in Chicago, Illinois, USA from June 5-9, 2006. This is the first bulletin announcing the date and location of the conference. This conference brings together world experts on calorimetry in high energy physics and related fields for in-depth discussions of the latest developments and innovations. With the LHC detector commissioning well underway and the ramping-up of ILC detector design activities, this year's conference promises to be particularly lively. We are preparing for up to 165 attendees with registration beginning within a few weeks. CALOR06 has been registered with the US State Department Conference Visa Program which should facilitate handling for those needing Visas.
