CALOR 2006, the twelfth in this series, will be held in Chicago, Illinois, USA from June 5-9, 2006. This is the second bulletin announcing the opening of registration for the conference. Please go to the web site to register, pay conference fees, and arrange for accommodations. Please fill out the registration form and submit before going to the payment and accommodation pages. You will then receive a confirmation e-mail with a promotional code for hotel room reservations.

CALOR 2006 has been registered with the US State Department Conference Visa Program which should facilitate handling for those needing Visas. If you need a Visa, please check the item on the registration form and an invitation letter and instructions for Visa application will be sent back to you.

Conference fees will be accepted by credit card (VISA, MC, American Express) and US bank checks in advance (until May 30th), or in cash (USD) at the conference. Please use the form on the web page with your choice of payment method. There is a possibility of some financial support for students and postdocs – please see the web page for more information.

The conference venue is the Kellogg School of Management located in downtown Chicago just off North Michigan Avenue on Northwestern University's Chicago campus. A block of hotel rooms has been reserved on a first-come, first-served basis at The Seneca Hotel and Suites – a 5 minute walk from the Conference location. On the Accommodation page of the web site, you will find a reservation form (Fax or phone) for the Seneca Hotel.

A tentative conference agenda is posted on the web site and we will accept requests for talks to be given at this all-plenary conference very shortly. An online talk request form for speakers will be

released in a few days. Please provide an abstract for your talk – all accepted abstracts will be provided to conference attendees in a booklet upon arrival.
