

# 12<sup>th</sup> International Conference on Calorimetry in High Energy Physics

CALOR 2006 is now less than 2 weeks away. Final arrangements for the conference are being concluded and several items must be noted.

**First and most important – the registration deadline for Early Payment of the registration fee (\$300 + \$65 for dinner) is MAY 30 – next Tuesday. If you haven't paid by then, you will have to pay \$350 + \$65 at the conference registration desk on Monday, June 5. Please refer to the Conference Fee web link for payment instructions.**

The final list of accepted abstracts is now on the web (click on “Accepted Abstracts” for the list). These abstracts have been included in the Tentative Schedule on the “Agenda” link (ppt file). Talks are listed by abstract number and author/presenter. All submitted talks are 20 minutes in length which includes questions and discussion. As you can see, the schedule is very tight – we will have to be strict about talk times.

We will use the CERN INDICO Agenda Server software for the final schedule and for uploading of talks in PDF and/or PPT format. This schedule will be available by Friday, May 26. Speakers will receive an e-mail from the INDICO server with instructions on how to register. You will then be able to upload your talk to this server by locating your name and talk title on the schedule. When this schedule is released, instructions on how to navigate the CALOR06 site and optimize your upload will appear on the CALOR06 web page. Using this server, talks can be uploaded up until the talk is scheduled (of course, depending on network availability). At the conference, a backup of all talks will be made at the end of each day so that the following day's talks can proceed even if the network is down.

Finally, we have 2 scheduled social events and some free time to explore Chicago. First, a conference reception will be held on Monday June 5 from 6 PM to 8:30 PM. It will be a cruise on Lake Michigan including drinks and hors d'oeuvres. When you pick up your registration package, you will receive tickets for this event. On Wednesday, June 7, there will be free time from ~3:30 PM to 7 PM. Suggestions of what to see and do during this time will also be included in the registration package. At 7 PM, the conference dinner will be held at the Chicago Cultural Center. Tickets for this event are \$65 – you can purchase additional tickets up until Monday, June 5 for this event.
