## **Design Inspiration**

The inspiration for this jacket came from the spectacular view at a favorite backcountry skiing destination in the mountains of western Canada. The scene on the jacket depicts sunrise over the mountains with a layer of clouds in the valley below. The mountains are blanketed in snow and the nearby lake is covered with ice.

## **Fabrics**

Assorted cotton prints.

## **Embellishments**

Tulle, braid, hand-made frog.

## **Patterns**

Vogue 2615.

## **Special Sewing Techniques**

The fabrics for the scene are applied onto a foundation using a machine blind stitch. The body of the jacket is quilted using free-motion stitching. The sleeves are pieced from randomly-cut curved pieces that are laid on a foundation. The raw edges are covered with bias strips. The jacket is lined to the edge and trimmed with braid.
