The successful candidate will be expected to start a federally funded experimental group in the Department and play a lead role in one or two additional faculty hires anticipated in the near future. Salary will be negotiable and commensurate with rank and experience, and attractive start up funding will be available. The Department has strong research programs in high energy theory, condensed matter/materials physics, and applied physics, and a new program in cosmology/astro-particle theory.
